Passover recalls our deliverance from slavery into freedom, from despair to hope, out of darkness and into the light. As we declare during the Passover celebration:

If the Lord had merely rescued us without dealing with our enemies – It would have been sufficient.

If He had only defeated our enemies without feeding us with manna – It would have been sufficient.

If He had only led us through the desert without giving us His Rest – It would have been enough.

If He had simply met us in Portland without the promise of Nashua – It would have been enough..... But our God goes way beyond "good enough". Let us lift up our cups of praise, thanking God for all He's done and for all He will most assuredly do. Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever! (Psalm 136:1)
